Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time -13^{th} August 23 - Year A

Dear Parishioners,

Deacon Kelemete and I attended the 2023 Archdiocesan Convocation of Clergy on Wednesday and Thursday of the past week.

Bolstered by the entire St Joseph's Primary School community, there was a good attendance at last Tuesday's special Mass for the **Solemnity Feast of St Mary of the Cross**. It is always important for a Parish such as ours who have a historical and continuing association with the **Sisters of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart** (the Josephites) via their Bage Street Convent; the two Parish Primary Schools: St Joseph's, Nundah and St Pius V, Banyo; and the Mary MacKillop College, Nundah. It is worth remembering that St Mary of the Cross is also the Patronal Saint of Australia and of the Archdiocese of Brisbane. St Mary of the Cross, pray for us!

This Tuesday, August 15, I will celebrate two Parish Masses to mark the Solemnity Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (a Holy Day of Obligation). The first will a 9:00am Mass in the Nundah church, the second will be a 6:30pm Mass in the Banyo church. I have deliberately opted for two Masses because (a) it is a Holy Day of Obligation, and (b) because it provides an opportunity for those whose work obligations preclude them from attending the 9:00am Mass in particular. It follows that since it is a Holy Day of Obligation, the Church and more specifically, our Parish has a responsibility to ensure that all Parishioners are given an opportunity to attend Mass on August 15. The Assumption, according to Church tradition, has infallibly and doctrinally declared that at the moment of the Blessed Virgin Mary's death, her body did not decay and that she was raised up (assumed), body and soul, into Heaven.

Wednesday, August 16, is a public holiday. The Parish Office will be closed for business on that day. I will be proceeding with the regular 9:00am Banyo Mass. All are most welcome.

I've been absent from the Parish for reasons of annual vacation and sick leave, and our Parish Secretary, Debra Visser, has been very competently keeping the Parish operations on the rails during that absence. Now, it is her turn to take a portion of annual leave to de-stress and switch-off for a while too. Debra will commence her vacation of 12 days from this Thursday, August 17. We will welcome her back on Monday, 28th August. As a supportive Parish community, we wish her a restful holiday.

While Debra's away, Marianne Davis has kindly agreed to fill-in as Acting Parish Secretary. Marianne has worked for us on a number of occasions earlier in 2023, so I know that our Parish operations will continue to run smoothly.
