Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time – 20^{th} August 23 – Year A

Dear Parishioners,

Once again, I am pleased to report that there was a strong attendance at last Tuesday's Mass for the **Solemnity Feast of The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**. Good attendances like that, particularly when a Holy Day of Obligation falls on a workday, augers well for us both as a Parish and the Church as a whole, because it demonstrates the strong and committed Faith of those who did attend Mass.

The Brisbane Archdiocese's Annual Catholic Campaign is being conducted today. The Campaign was launched last weekend during our Sunday Masses. and Parishioners desirous of participating in the Campaign, were invited to take home one of the Campaign Appeal envelopes, and to complete it and return it today. Payment options include cash, cheque, direct debit and credit card. For those who hadn't taken one of the Campaign Appeal envelopes home last Sunday, there is still a good supply of the envelopes still available near the entrances of our two churches (main and side doors). I would ask that you place your completed Campaign envelopes in the Mass Collection baskets at the same time that the Parish Mass Collections are taken up. But, because the Campaign envelopes and money is being directed to the Archdiocese, it is important that the Parish can distinguish between its own Collection money and the Campaign money, so please ensure that your Campaign envelope has been fully sealed so that its contents is not intermingled with the Parish's loose monies. On behalf of the Archbishop, thank you for your financial support of the Archdiocese.

Thank you for your prayerful support of the children who will be making their First Holy Communion during next Sunday's (including the Saturday Vigil) Masses. I understand that there will a few children at each Sunday Mass time, so when it comes to Communion time, I would ask Parishioners to allow the children making their First Holy Communion to come forward first to receive the Precious Body and Blood of Christ, and then when they have made their First Communion. I will invite everyone else to come forward to receive their Communion. A big thank you to Angela Greathead for preparing this group of children for their First Holy Communion. I note also for the benefit of the families of children making their First Holy Communion that rehearsals for First Holy Communion will occur at 4:00pm this week on Wednesday (Banyo) and Thursday (Nundah) afternoons.

I would add that any children having completed their Sacraments of Initiation (i.e. Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) are eligible to serve in the very special role of Altar Servers. I hope that there would be some from among our new First Holy Communicant group who might consider, with their parents' permissions, serving in this capacity. There is some prerequisite training required before beginning to formally Altar Serve, and I would be delighted to facilitate that training and to have additional Servers come on board. Please consider this invitation.


