Dear Parishioners,

CONGRATULATIONS! WHAT A SPECIAL DAY!

Congratulations to all our First Holy Communicants making their First Holy Communion today. It is a wonderful achievement. With the reception of this Sacrament, each of them have become fully initiated Catholics and their standing is equal to that of all fully initiated Catholics. To be fully initiated means that they have completed all three Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. And associated with the honour of being fully initiated, another privilege is extended to them: they are now eligible (with the requisite preparation and training) to assist at the Altar as an Altar Server. I would hope that many of our First Holy Communicants might volunteer and commit themselves, with their parents' consent, to Altar Serving regularly at our Parish Sunday Masses. Altar Serving is an important and significant ministry within our Church.

A big thankyou must also go to the families of the First Holy Communicants who have journeyed with their children. Supporting one's child/ren in this fashion requires an element of sacrificial love; giving-up on certain things to ensure that their child/ren are able to attend and participate in the preparatory lessons conducted by Angela Greathead, our Parish Sacramental Coordinator. Angela, too, has sacrificed many Saturday's conducting the preparatory lessons, and for that, I am also most grateful for her dedication and commitment to this task. Thanks, Angela!

Some Parishioners noted from last weekend's Newsletter that Elizabeth (Beth) Hart's name was in the Recently Deceased section of the Newsletter but no further details were supplied. I apologise for not sharing a little more detail about Beth's funeral with interested Parishioners because the Annual Catholic Campaign being conducted at our Sunday Masses took centre stage in my mind. I now correct that oversight and can share the following information for any Parishioner who might be desirous of attending Beth's Funeral Mass. Beth passed away in the early hours of Friday, 17 August; she was a patient in the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital at the time. Because there are some relatives who are arriving from overseas, her funeral has been delayed to this Wednesday, 30 August, in the Holy Trinity Church. The funeral service will commence at 11:15am. The cortege will depart for the Nudgee Cemetery at the conclusion of the Church service. Many people including Beth's former Parish Priest, Fr John Sullivan, attest to her great humanity and her deep faith. She will be deeply missed.

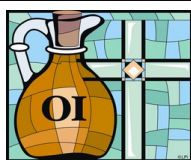
PARISH CRAFT GROUP
