The 5th anniversary of the St Teresa of Calcutta Shrine at Marian Valley, Canungra, is on Saturday, 07 October 2023.

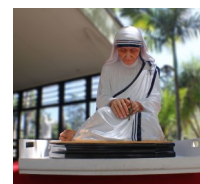
The anniversary will be celebrated with a Mass at 11 am followed by a procession to the Shrine at 12 pm.

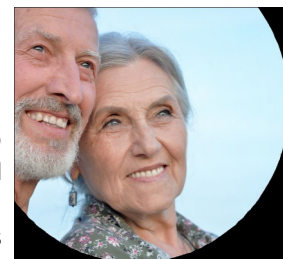
Share your Blessings:

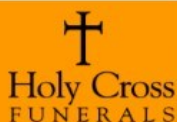
