Dear Parishioners,

My sincere thanks go to **Irene Endicott** for coming forward last weekend to assist the Parish as a RCIA Sponsor. I included the names of all the RCIA Candidates, their Sponsors and Catechists in last weekend's Parish Newsletter and I invited you to remember them in your prayers as the Parish proceeds with its 2023-2024 RCIA Program. Please include Irene in your prayers for the success of our RCIA Program too.

I again exhort all Parishioners to be alert and cautious when travelling on our nation's roads during the current school vacation period which concludes after the Queensland King's Birthday Long Weekend (2 October). A number of road crash fatalities have occurred in Queensland in the first week of the vacation. Whether these accidents involve people travelling on vacations, one can't be entirely sure, but statistically, there is greater danger for road users during school vacations, hence, my call for caution.

Today's First Reading from the Prophet Isaiah quotes the Lord saying, '...my thoughts are not your thoughts, my ways not your ways – it is the Lord who speaks. Yes, the heavens are as high above earth as my ways are above your ways, my thoughts above your thoughts.' I offer a small reflection on these words for your consideration: How small our thoughts can be and poor our ways of seeing and judging. We think miserly thoughts, and act in miserly ways. Why? Because we have small minds and small hearts. A short prayer to complement this reflection:

Lord, open our minds and enlarge our hearts, so that we think more like you, and act more like you. Let us not begrudge your goodness to others, knowing that we too are undeserving of your favours, and stand more in need of your mercy than of your justice. Amen.

Monica is the daughter of Justin and Margaret Carr, who are well known members of the Corpus Christi worshipping community. Their wedding is my first in this Parish since I began my tenure as your Parish Priest.
