Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe - Year A 26th November 23

Dear Parishioners,

Today, Sunday, marks the final Sunday of the Church's Liturgical Year. Today, we honour our Lord Jesus Christ as King of the Universe. Today also marks the beginning of the final week of our Brisbane Catholic Education (BCE) school year; they begin their Christmas school vacation from Friday.

With the school year coming to a close, it also means that the Parish's pastoral ministries are busier with school Year 6 Graduation and End-of-Year Masses, which are on top of our regular Parish Mass obligations. Last Monday (20 November), I celebrated the St Joseph's Primary School Year 6 Graduation; this Wednesday evening, it will be the turn of the St Pius V Primary School. I congratulate the Year 6 Graduands for the completion of their journey through Primary School. Equally, I congratulate the Year 12 students who have already completed their Secondary School education and who are in the interregnum period between their commencement of tertiary studies or seeking gainful employment. Then, on Friday, December 1 (the final day of the school year), I will be celebrating an End-of-Year Whole of School Mass for each Parish Primary School. The first will occur at 9:00am in the Nundah Church, and of course, all Parishioners are invited to attend and participate in this Mass. The second will commence at 10:45am and it will be celebrated in the Multi-Purpose Hall on the St Pius V Primary School precinct.

I would draw Parishioners, particularly those who regularly attend our Parish Weekday Masses that there is a change to the Mass routine for this Thursday only. I will be celebrating a 10:30am Anoint Mass in the Holy Trinity Church. After Mass, our Parish Care and Concern team will cater for a morning tea/luncheon for all attendees in the adjacent Brady Hall. Since the Thursday Mass is being celebrated earlier in the day, the regular 6:30pm Thursday night Mass is a cancellation. My thanks to Madonna Hoelscher and her Care and Concern Committee for their generosity to our Parish community throughout 2023 – your work is deeply appreciated.

Now, it may seem a little premature to write about our Christmas Masses which is still a month away, but I have been approached by quite a few Parishioners already seeking to clarify their Sunday/Christmas Day obligations. Their enquiries are valid because this year, we have the 4th Sunday of Advent occurring on Sunday, December 24 and Christmas Day falling on Monday, December 25. People have asked if they attend one of the two Parish Christmas Eve Vigil Masses, does that fulfil both their Sunday and Christmas Day obligations? Well, the simple answer is 'NO'. They're two separate liturgical celebrations - the 4th Sunday of Advent and Christmas and each has its own obligations that need to be fulfilled by Catholic Christians. Christmas Day, because it is a moveable Solemnity Feast is one of two Holy Days of Obligation in our Australian Church calendar. The other Holy Day of Obligation is the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and it falls on August 15 of every year. So, returning to my earlier question, the answer is that all Catholics are bound to attend and celebrate Mass on both the 4th Sunday AND Christmas Day. For some Parishioners, they may choose to attend Mass twice on Sunday December 24, the first being on Sunday morning (the 4th Sunday of Advent) and the second on Sunday night (the Christmas Vigil Mass).
