First Sunday in Advent - Year B 3rd December 2023

Dear Parishioners.

Today, Sunday, marks the first Sunday of the Church's new Liturgical Year. We begin the Season of Advent. And I wish to give people a little heads-up about how we will be celebrating the blessing and lighting of the Advent Wreath Candles because it will more than likely be slightly different to how you celebrated the lighting of the Advent Wreath Candles from Fr Bernie Gallagher's time. This process will be repeated for all four Sundays of Advent.

The Process:

After the Sign of the Cross and opening remarks, but before the Penitential Rite begins, the Advent Wreath Candle will be blessed and lit. In blessing the candles, I will move across to the Advent Wreath and pray the prayer of blessing and on completion of the blessing prayer, the Advent Candle will be lit. After the Candle has been lit, the church musician, choir and people will sing the words: 'Wait in joyful hope; a Saviour will come. Jesus Christ, the light of the world. Wait in joyful hope; a Saviour will come, welcome to

Upon completion of this brief Rite, the Introductory Rite of the Mass will continue as per normal.

I've reported previously in last Sunday's Newsletter Message that our Catholic Primary Schools would conclude their school year on Friday, 1 December. They are now on their Christmas Summer Vacation. The past week has been a busy one liturgically for me what with Graduation and Endof-Year Masses with the School Communities, and an Anointing Mass on Thursday morning. But now that the schools are on vacation, it is time to be extra cautious when travelling on our highways and byways. Traffic is heavier because of the increased vehicular traffic from tourists and vacationers between now and the Australia Day Long Weekend. Our Lord cautions his disciples to 'Stay awake!' three times in today's Gospel Reading. Of course, we should always be doing this from a spiritual sense, but, we can equally apply the same logic at peak holiday/traffic times too, so that we avoid becoming a statistic.

The Messages by Jesus to his disciples to 'Stay awake!' or to 'Be prepared!' in the Gospels are strong ones indeed. Because Jesus has placed a clear emphasis on both, it would indeed be negligent were we to ignore them. By way of support to all Parishioners to be in a heightened state of readiness, I will again be offering a **Second Rite of Reconciliation** celebration to each Church community prior to Christmas. The first will be celebrated in the Corpus Christi Church, Nundah, and the second, in the Holy Trinity Church, Banyo. Both services will commence promptly at **6:30pm**. **Nundah's** will be celebrated on **Monday, 11 December**, and **Banyo's** on **Friday, 15 December** – all are most welcome to these penitential services. In addition to the Second Rite celebrations, there will be the regular Saturday afternoon First Rite sessions in the Banyo church that start from 4:00pm. Please give serious consideration to attending at least one of these reconciliation opportunities prior to Christmas.




