## Second Sunday of Advent — 10th December 23 — Year B

Dear Parishioners,

Our Parish Secretary, Debra Visser, has taken a well-earned break during the past week, and during her absence, we've welcomed back to the Parish, Marianne Davis as Acting Parish Secretary and I thank Marianne for her service. Debra will be back tomorrow, Monday.

This past week has been a remarkable contrast when compared with the previous week. The previous week was the final week of the school year for Catholic schools. There was an enhanced busyness with everything that is usually associated with final school weeks (e.g. Graduation and End-of-School Year Masses). That just goes to show how much the Parish actually interacts with our Parish schools. This week, in the absence of funeral services, has been a very easy one, and in many ways, a relaxed one. In fact, I have been able to make some headway towards preparing for the Fourth Sunday of Advent — Christmas Parish services. And that is indeed timely, because the Parish Office will be officially closed from 4:30pm, Friday, 22 December 2023 through to 9:00am Tuesday, 2 January 2024, and therefore, the Parish Secretary and I have the big task of variously preparing Parish Newsletters, homilies, and liturgies.

A final reminder to all Parishioners, that our Parish, in an effort to assist Parishioners to 'prepare a way for the Lord' from this weekend's Gospel, will celebrate two Second Rite of Reconciliation services this week. The first will be tomorrow, Monday, in Corpus Christi Church, and the second will be on Friday in the Holy Trinity Church; both services will commence promptly at 6:30pm. All are most welcome to participate.

A few remarks now about our current Parish RCIA Program. Our three original Candidates, Graham Mitchell, Heather Speechley and Jayden Speechly-Shagam have now reached the mid-point of the Program. They will anointed with the Oil of Catechumens during our Sunday 9:30am Mass. They will soon be joined by a fourth RCIA Candidate, Carlie Clark, who is a late starter to the Program. The arrangement that I have agreed with Carlie is that she would join the remaining RCIA Group Meetings with Graham, Heather and Jayden, and when they finished their Program, that Carlie would continue for a further six or seven meetings in order to cover the material that she had skipped over. So, in effect, the Parish will be operating two distinct but concurrent RCIA Programs for the four Candidates. To have four Candidates seeking to become members of our Faith Tradition in our Parish is a wonderful development and I hope that it continues to have your prayerful support.

I pray that the coming week will be a spirit-filled one for all Parishioners, and I wish you God's blessing on all your endeavours.


