This past week I celebrated a Second Rite of Reconciliation service in each Church (Monday, Nundah, and Friday, Banyo). These are the second occasions of my celebrating within the Parish of the Second Rite of Reconciliation. The first occasion was during Lent 2023. My perception is that there has been a modest growth in the Advent attendances when compared with the Lenten attendances. Perhaps even more Parishioners might attend and be reconciled with the Lord when they are next offered during Lent 2024, and as your Spiritual Leader, I do hope so.

Our RCIA Program has now been suspended until Sunday, January 14, when the three Candidates, Graham Mitchell, Heather Speechly and her son, Jayden Speechley-Shagam, will enrol their names into the Book of the Elect. This is a major step in their journey of enquiry towards becoming members of the Roman Catholic Church. Please continue to offer them your prayerful support.


During our December 8 Parish Mass (The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary), I mentioned how this Feast Day was the 22nd anniversary of my admission into the Sacrament of Holy Orders as a Deacon. Deaconate Ordination anniversaries tend to be ignored by many Priests as being unimportant in the grand scheme of things, whereas their Presbyteral and Episcopal Ordinations are remembered annually. I could never quite understand why one's admission into the clerical state as a Deacon in the service of the Church is downplayed as much as it is. Thank you again to the well-wishers who came forward to congratulate me on that achievement, and may I ask for your continued prayers for me as the first year of my pastoral ministry to you as your Parish Priest soon comes to an end.

May the Lord shower his blessings upon you and your families as we patiently await the coming of the Christ-child at Christmas.


