### **Something to Think About**

How do you get ready for Christmas?

What happens at school, at home and at church during Advent while we wait for Jesus' birth?

### **The Story**

The gospel this week starts with words from the prophet Isaiah: "In the desert, someone is shouting, 'Get the road ready for the Lord! Make a straight path for him." Then it moves on to the story of John the Baptist. John was the one shouting in the desert, telling people to turn back to God. John baptised people with water in the Jordan River, but he also told the people that someone more powerful than him would come and baptise them with the Holy Spirit. That 'someone more powerful', was Jesus.

### **The Scriptures**

### A reading from the holy gospel according to Mark

1:1-8

This is the good news about Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

It began just as God had said in the book written by Isaiah the prophet,

"I am sending my messenger to get the way ready for you.

In the desert someone is shouting,

'Get the road ready for the Lord! Make a straight path for him.'"

So John the Baptist showed up in the desert and told everyone,

"Turn back to God and be baptised! Then your sins will be forgiven."

From all Judea and from Jerusalem crowds of people went to John.

They told how sorry they were for their sins, and he baptised them in the Jordan River. John wore clothes made of camel's hair. He had a leather strap around his waist and ate

grasshoppers and wild honey. John also told the people,

"Someone more powerful is going to come.

And I am not good enough even to stoop down and until his sandals.

I baptise you with water, but he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit!"
