The Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time 11 February 2024 - Year B

Dear Parishioners,

The Church's liturgical season of Lent is once again upon us from Wednesday of this Week (Ash Wednesday). Lent is above all is a penitential season that affords us the time and opportunity for prayer, self-denial and helping our neighbours. We all do this at an individual level but the season enables the whole Church to prepare for Easter with those who are to be baptised on the occasion of the Easter Vigil. However, in our Parish this Lenten season, our Candidates being received into the Church through the RCIA program will do so a little earlier. For our three RCIA Candidates, they will be received in our Catholic family on Sunday, 10 March. This Sunday, during our 9:30am Mass, our three Candidates, Heather Speechly, her son, Jayden, and Graham Mitchell, will undertake their Second Scrutiny. Please continue to remember them in your daily prayers as their journey of faith moves towards its final weeks.

With Lent being so near, I would like to take this occasion to map out our Parish's Lenten liturgical and devotional activities and when they are scheduled to occur (please see the back page of newsletter). This will allow all who are interested (and I hope that might be everyone who is physically able) to reserve those dates, times and events in your own personal diaries. Printing a copy and displaying it prominently may be very helpful.

I draw to your attention in the Table on page four that there are two days the Church nominates as **Days of Fast and Abstinence** during Lent, and they are **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**. Here is a simple explanation of the Church's laws of fasting and abstinence. The Church's **law of fasting** binds those who have completed their eighteenth year until the beginning of their sixtieth year. The Church's **law of abstinence** (from meat) binds those who have completed their fourteenth year and this law applies for the remainder of one's life.

I am delighted to report that whilst our current RCIA program will close in a month's time, I have fielded three inquiries from individuals who are also interested in converting to Catholicism. I have indicated to these individuals that our Parish will run an additional RCIA program beginning around mid-April. I will again be seeking the assistance of Parishioners to serve as Catechists and Sponsors to these new Candidates.

Last Wednesday night, I conducted two training and briefing sessions for our Parish Extraordinary Ministers of the Word and Eucharist. We had a good attendance overall, but not all of our Extraordinary Ministers attended. I was genuinely surprised and pleased with the number of our Parishioners who have volunteered to serve in both ministries. My main emphasis was on teamwork (i.e. working collaboratively with one another) so that our Parish Sunday Mass liturgies are more homogeneous in our two Parish church buildings which are significantly different from an architectural perspective. One of the main adaptations will be for all ministers rostered for a Sunday Mass to meet with me in the Priests' Sacristy ten minutes prior to the scheduled Mass start time for a short period of prayer and to confirm with one another who will be doing what and where during the Mass. Thank you in advance for helping me to bed down these small changes will come into effect from next Sunday, the First Sunday of Lent.

Caritas Australia's annual Project Compassion Campaign takes effect from Ash Wednesday. The programme uses a system of weekly donation envelopes which contributors are requested to use to lodge their contributions during Lent. Contributors are asked to lodge their sealed envelopes in the normal Sunday Mass Collection baskets and these funds will be forwarded to Caritas Australia. Project Compassion is one of the ways that we can respond to the Church's call for self-denial and helping our neighbours, and I therefore commend your support of this pastoral outreach. An alternative to the Project Compassion donation envelopes is to use the QR Code on the back of the envelopes and make contributions digitally and directly to Caritas Australia.

May this week be a successful one and may your Lenten journey draw you ever closer to the Lord. God's blessing on you all!
