The Third Sunday of Easter 14 April 2024 - Year B

Dear Parishioners,

The mid-semester school vacation comes to an end today, and the craziness of people returning home via road from their vacations is upon us again. It means that families who are attempting to maximise their vacation away from home, will be racing the clock to get back home and our State's roads will be busy and chaotic. Again I'll repeat, as I tend to do towards the end of every school vacation, please be patient and careful if you are out driving anywhere this weekend because I want you to live rather then become a road statistic.

Your Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) met again on Wednesday night. It was a good and constructive meeting. One of the topics discussed was our upcoming RCIA Program, our second such program for 2024. In recent weeks I have mentioned in my weekly Newsletter Messages that the Parish is in need of Parishioners to come forward to serve as RCIA Sponsors. I did receive one self-nomination last Sunday, plus one sponsor from a previous RCIA program has committed herself to doing so again, but we still need two more nominees. It was suggested by the PPC that I might be more successful in recruiting the required Sponsor if I was to explain the role and expectations, because there is a natural hesitancy for people to avoid committing themselves to something if their understanding of what the role entails is vague. So, by way of response to their suggestion, I offer the following information.

RCIA Sponsor Role and Expectations

A RCIA Sponsor walks beside their appointed Candidate. It is not essential that a Sponsor has completed theological studies. Nor is a person's age an issue, save to say that they should be a fully initiated Catholic (i.e. baptised, confirmed and made their first Holy Communion), and above the age of 18. They serve as a companion and a friend to their Candidate. The RCIA program has a general duration of 13 or 14 weeks. There is a weekly group meeting of all Candidates, Sponsors and Catechists during which general discussions occur on particular topics that pertain to our study textbook, At Home With God's People. These meetings generally last between 60 and 90 minutes. Each Candidate, Sponsor and Catechist has their own free copy of the textbook, so there is no personal expense involved, the only cost to any participant is their personal time. By working through the textbook, all participants will attain a more general knowledge and understanding of the Catholic Faith, and that can only be beneficial for the participants. The day and time of the week for our regular meetings will be decided by all participants at the very start, so that means that any prospective Sponsor will have a say about when the group will meet. There is one more aspect of serving as a Sponsor that I should mention, and that is that a various times (i.e. Sundays) that the Sponsor stands beside their Candidate as the Candidate is enrolled or receives minor exorcisms and, finally, when they are received into the Church and receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. Being a Sponsor is a most rewarding and fulfilling duty, and I highly commend it to all Parishioners. So, please, I ask for your help in coming forward and nominating yourself to share in this rewarding experience. Please, I really need to finalise this aspect of the RCIA Program this weekend so that the Program can begin in earnest. Thank Continued on page two you.


