Dear Parishioners,

the Procession.

Damien and Colleen Bond have concluded their hospitality ministry to our Banyo 7:30am Fourth Sunday congregation. The couple have moved house from Banyo to Warner. Last Sunday was their final serving of breakfast after Mass. The Parish is greatly indebted to them both for their exemplary service to the Parish, but also because they make the generous effort to be present to serve the 7:30am congregation, only to then return to participate in their own regular Sunday Mass time of 5:00pm. The couple are slowly withdrawing from their numerous Parish ministries, and by year's end, all will cease. On behalf of this Parish, I sincerely thank them for their long involvement in various ministries within this Parish, and I can honestly say that they will be missed by us all. We wish them all the very best for the future.

With Damien and Colleen having now concluded their hospitality ministry to the Banyo 7:30am Fourth Sunday congregation, the Parish is on the search for volunteers to continue this ministry. If anyone is interested in continuing this ministry, may I ask you to either telephone or email the Parish Manager, Debra Visser, sometime during this week. Thank you.

I wrote a little about the Parish's upcoming Corpus Christi Street Procession in last weekend's Newsletter Message. I would like to expand on that some more.

To date, the majority of the planning and organisation has been undertaken by the Parish Manager and myself; these include seeking the approval of the Brisbane City Council and Queensland Police for the Procession to proceed. We have prepared the groundworks, but now it is time to enlist the help of Parishioners to make this event a success. The Queensland Police have stipulated certain tasks to be undertaken by the Parish, and these include the presence of Parade Marshalls (we require a minimum of four persons) and a First Aid Officer (someone from among our Parish-base who is either a medical doctor, or registered nurse or a paramedic would be ideal). All that is required that a Parade Marshall to do is to walk in the Procession and to ensure that it flows smoothly; you will also have to wear a hi-vis vest provided by the Parish to distinguish yourself to others. The First Aid Officer hopefully will have little to do, but it is purely a precautionary role to assist anyone who might suffer difficulties during the Procession.

There are other tasks too for which I seek volunteers, and these include:

A Cross Bearer and two Candle Bearer Altar Servers to process before me as I carry the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance at the head of the Procession.
A Holy Rosary Prayer Leader/s to lead the praying of the Holy Rosary during

•Volunteers (ideally associated with the different groups who serve our Parish and the broader community) to carry prepared banners (two per banner). There are a total of eight banners which represent a diverse crosssection of our Parish community. The plan is that those marchers in the Procession would follow behind a or the banner that best suits their interest. The banners will include a lead banner which identifies ourselves as a Parish, then the other banners in no particular order are: our Parish Youth Ministry, the Eucharistic Adoration group, the Care and Concern group, the Laudato si group, the Real Presence SVDP Conference (Nundah) group, the Holy Trinity SVDP Conference (Banyo) group, and a general banner for Parishioners who do not generally associate with any of the preceding groups.

•Volunteers to cook and serve others at a barbecue to be set-up in the Nundah Parish carpark; food would be served once the Procession has returned to the Corpus Christi Church and until 1:00pm.

• Volunteers to serve cold drinks to patrons.

•Volunteers to assist with the liturgical celebrations associated with the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on the Processions return and for the concluding Benediction which will commence at 1:00pm.

The Corpus Christi Procession, which will conclude our Parish's 2024 celebration of our weeklong Feastival (i.e. Holy Trinity Sunday and Corpus Christi Sunday), is four weeks away, so it is important that the Parish can finalise these arrangements early so that we avoid having to rush around and find last minute volunteers. So, if there are among our Parishioner-base those who would be willing to participate in one or more of these tasks, I would ask you to contact our Parish Manager and leave your name and the specific roles that you are able to serve in.

The Procession itself will begin and end in the Nundah Church carpark. It will commence at 11:00am and ought to take about 30 minutes at a very slow pace to complete. Queensland Police will assist by providing lead

and tail patrol vehicles so that our Procession will flow uninterrupted, as well as other Police Officers who will undertake traffic-duty at the maior intersections along the route. The route itself will be along Bage Street in a northerly direction, then turning right onto Boyd Street, turning right onto Sandgate Road, and turning right again onto Chapel Street, and



turning left onto Bage Street. It is a simple route and it affords our Parish community to publicly bear witness to the local community of Nundah, our faith in Jesus Christ, and to promote the diversity of our Parish to those who might otherwise be oblivious **to** how our Church serves them. I would highly recommend to all Parishioners to participate in this Procession on Sunday, 2 June 2024. Thank you.

Alpha is for anyone, anywhere, to freely explore their unique questions about life, faith and God.




ROSTER HELP!
