## The Ascension of the Lord 12<sup>th</sup> May 2024 - Year B

Dear Parishioners,

Today, Sunday, is Mother's Day again. I remember fondly my own late mother's love and sacrifice both for myself and my nine siblings. I don't think that I am alone in expressing my indebtedness to her. I think most children deeply appreciate their mothers. So, today, may I wish all Parishioners who are mothers, a very happy and holy Mother's Day for 2024. May today be a restful and memorable one for each of you.

Today, in the Australian Church, the Church celebrates the Solemnity Feast of the Ascension of the Lord. In other countries, the Feast is actually celebrated on the fortieth day after the Resurrection of the Lord, which is the Thursday in the 6th week of Easter. The Ascension celebrates our Lord's body and soul ascending into Heaven and His taking His seat at the right hand of His Father, as proclaimed in the Gospels. His Ascension marks the completion of His earthly mission. Jesus first united His divine nature with human nature through the Incarnation at the moment of the Annunciation. Saint Thomas Aquinas teaches that from that moment on, Jesus, the Son of God, experienced three types of knowledge. First, being God, He had beatific knowledge, that is, a direct knowledge of His essence, the Father's essence, and the Holy Spirit's essence. Second, He had the perfection of infused knowledge, that is, a bestowal of all truths given to the angels in Heaven, especially those truths necessary for the completion of His divine mission. And third, He began to acquire learned knowledge, or experiential knowledge. This was the form of knowledge attained through His human nature from the senses and His human reason.

As Jesus fulfilled His mission through life, His learned knowledge continued to grow until it was perfected in human form. It was never imperfect in the sense of sin, but only in the sense of growth through human experience and human love. He experienced all things, allowed the perfection of His beatific and infused knowledge to guide His human experiences and brought those human experiences and knowledge to perfection. His free embrace of the Cross manifested the perfection of divine love in human form, and His Resurrection brought that perfect unity of human and divine love to a new and transformed resurrected state of human existence. But that was not all. Today we commemorate the fact that Jesus took His perfected human nature into the Beatific Vision, enabling humanity itself to follow. The Blessed Virgin Mary was the first to do so given her sinless state.

Next Sunday is the Solemnity Feast of Pentecost which is openly observed as being the birth of the Church. There will be more about this Feast in next weekend's Newsletter message.

I wrote at great length in last weekend's Newsletter Message about the upcoming Corpus Christi Street March that our Parish would be staging. I also called for Parishioners to kindly respond by volunteering themselves to assist with certain aspects of the March and our final Corpus Christi (Feastival) celebrations. During last Sunday's Masses, I publicly asked if volunteers might contact our Parish Manager, Debra Visser, to



lodge your name and if you so desire, to specify which task that you would be interested in undertaking, and to do so by close of business on Friday. As of close of business on Wednesday, the Parish had received a total of three volunteers. We are a long way shy of filling out the entire roster. To assist all who are interested in volunteering, I have prepared a form with all the volunteer positions listed that still need to be filled. I have placed the clipboard near the front door of our churches so that Parishioners can append their names, and in the case of the March Marshalls and the First Aid Officer, we would require your mobile telephone numbers too. The mobile numbers are necessary so that should an incident or accident occur during the March, that the Marshalls and First Aid Officers can communicate quickly with one another and the Police who will bookend our March. I beg you to strongly and prayerfully consider assisting in these voluntary roles. Our Parish's Corpus Christi Street March is another way of publicly bearing witness to our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. It also serves to demonstrate that our local Church is strong and active in the community too.

Finally, I offer you an update on our second RCIA Program in 2024. To run two Programs in the same calendar year is a unique experience for me and for many Catholic Parishes.

Our second RCIA Program is up and running. You might remember how I reported in previous Newsletter Messages of how the number of participants in the Program continued to swell from 3 to 6. There is clearly a desire within the hearts and minds of these 6 people (3 men and 3 women) to further explore our Catholic Faith and Traditions. If all goes according to schedule, the 6 participants will conclude their personal journeys of discovery and awareness during the 9:30am Sunday Mass on August 25. Of the 6 participants, 4 are unbaptised (they are Sakiko Hirata, Jennifer van Iperen, Felix Bonomini and Myles Payne) and will be installed as catechumens during next Sunday's 9:30am Mass, the remaining 2 (being Carlie Clark and David Thompson) have been baptised in other Christian faiths, and their journeys will be as Candidates. So, once again, I appeal for your prayerful support for these 6 people, along with their Sponsors and Catechists, as they journey towards full reception in our Church family. Thank you!

May the Lord continue to bless you and your loved ones throughout the week ahead.
