Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

17 November 2024 — Year B

Dear Parishioners,

Antony Sebastian, a Seminarian from the Holy Spirit Provincial Seminary, Banyo, joins us today to begin his 6-week pastoral placement in our Parish. You will recall from last week's Parish Newsletter, Antony provided us with a short biography of his faith journey, and that he is a Seminarian attached to the Adelaide Archdiocese. Please make him welcome.

This weekend is the penultimate Sunday in the Church's liturgical year. The Readings for today carry a distinct apocalyptic message to us. The Prophet Daniel speaks of St Michael the Archangel standing guard over God's Holy People; the Letter to the Hebrews speaks of the perfect sacrifice made by our Lord and Saviour that takes away all sin and he contrasts that with the imperfect sacrifices offered by the Temple priests which are incapable of taking away all sin; and in Mark's Gospel, Jesus speaks to his disciples about the Parousia – His Second Coming. The overarching theme we can deduce from the scriptural passage, as Jesus Himself mentions time and again, is to be in a state of preparedness, as he says in the final verse of today's Gospel, 'But as for that day or hour, nobody knows it, neither the angels of heaven, nor the Son; no one but the Father.' And to assist all Parishioners to maintain this state of preparedness, I will again, during Advent in addition to our Parish's weekly Saturday afternoon reconciliation sessions at Banyo, a Second Rite of Reconciliation for each Church community: the first being at 6:30pm on Friday 13 December in the Holy Trinity Church, Banyo; and the second at 6:30am Monday 16 December in the Corpus Christi Church, Nundah.

The Church celebrates the Solemnity Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe next Sunday, 24 November, and then of course, we enter into the Season of Advent, beginning the new liturgical year with Sunday cycle C and weekday cycle 1. Next Sunday's 5:00pm Banyo Mass will be the final Family Mass hosted by the St Pius V Primary School for the 2024 calendar year. A catered supper generally follows on after the conclusion of the Family Mass.

The final Anointing Mass for 2024 will be celebrated on Thursday, 28 November, at Banyo and it will commence at 10:30am. Because of the earlier Mass on Thursday, the regular 6:30pm evening Mass at Banyo for that night will be a cancellation. People with serious health issues or are elderly are most welcome to attend and receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

May the Lord continue to bless your endeavours throughout the week ahead. God bless!
