# **Something to Think About**

# **The Story**

There was an offering box near the temple where people came to give money. Many rich people put a lot of money in the box. A poor widow, a lady whose husband had died, had only two coins left to live on. She put both of those coins into the offering box. Jesus said these two coins were worth more than all the money the rich people gave since they had given their extra money that they didn't need.

### A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark

12:41-44

Jesus was sitting in the temple near the offering box and watching people put in their gifts. He noticed that many rich people were giving a lot of money.

Finally, a poor widow came up and put in two coins that were worth only a few pennies.

Jesus told his disciples to gather around him.

Then he said:

"I tell you that this poor widow has put in more than all the others.

Everyone else gave what they didn't need.

But she is very poor and gave everything she had.

Now she doesn't have a cent to live on."

# **Group Activity**


MONEY BOX CUBE
