Blessing of the Advent Wreath Candle - Week 2 - Peace

Fr Dan: Father, we ask you to bless ★ this second candle, as we celebrate *Peace*.

Faithful God, you sent into the world your beloved Son as a light that shines in darkness.

As we light this second candle, increase the *Peace* in our hearts and help us to prepare a smooth path for the Saviour.

[The second Advent Wreath candle is now lit. After the candle has been lit, the people pray together:]

All: May the flame of Christ's coming grow brighter and brighter. May the Lord of Light come into each of our hearts and into our world.

Dear Parishioners,

Our Parish Schools have now closed for the year. The past week has been a busy one for the Parish, especially in relation to our two Parish Primary Schools, St Joseph's, Nundah, and St Pius V, Banyo, what with their respective Year 6 Graduation and End-of-Year Masses. May the staff and students enjoy a good rest during the Christmas holiday period, and come back to us, rejuvenated to begin again in late January 2025.

In the first Sunday Masses in both Parish churches, we will continue to decorate each church's Christmas Tree with more baubles as an acknowledgement of the grand work that people from within our Parish family do in their liturgical and communitarian ministries. Over the four Sundays, you will see a number of individuals being publicly recognised and honoured on multiple occasions. And when you do see this occur, you will begin to appreciate the magnitude of their deep love of neighbour and the individual sacrifices that they are prepared to make for the greater good. Today we honour and thank those who clean our churches and care for the gardens and lawns of our Parish properties; the Admin Angels, being those who voluntarily assist our Parish Staff and help reduce our Parish administrative workloads; those who launder and iron our church linen; those who serve as members of the Parish Finance Council who assist me in the important role of financial stewardship of Parish assets and our finances; those who serve as Vincentians in the two Vinnies Conferences that serve the broader public, regardless of one's faith, colour or ethnicity, and often take additional responsibly for organising elements in our Sunday liturgies, such as, Offertory Collections, et cetera; and finally, those who are environment, responsible for the art and including arrangements. Again, I will call these generous and selfless individuals to come forward towards the end of each Sunday Mass to receive a small gift from the Parish for their services.

A reminder that I shall be celebrating the first of two Second Rites of Reconciliation services this week. It will commence at 6:30pm on Friday evening and the venue will be our Banyo church. If that time or day doesn't suit you, the second Reconciliation service will be held next Monday evening, at the same time of 6:30pm, and the venue for that celebration will be our Nundah church.
