Blessing of the Advent Wreath Candle - Week 3 - Joy

Fr Dan: Father, we ask you to bless ₹ this third candle, as

we celebrate Joy.

Faithful God, you sent into the world your beloved Son as

Good News that shines in the darkness.

As we light our third candle, increase our *Joy* and help us to be Good News to all people.

[The third Advent Wreath candle is now lit. After the candle has been lit, the people pray together:]

All: May the flame of Christ's coming grow brighter and brighter. May the Lord of Light come into each of our hearts and into our world.

Dear Parishioners,

The Third Sunday of Advent is known as *Gaudete* Sunday. The word *'gaudete'* means 'rejoice'. This invitation to rejoice is reflected in the Scripture readings. The optional colour for today is rose. The Advent Wreath candle that will be lit today along with my chasuble are rose-coloured.

In today's Masses, we pay tribute to those in our Parish family who serve us, and in many instance, the broader community too. As 2024 is coming to an end, I would hope that perhaps, through the recognition of those who serve in various ministries, this recognition process might stimulate a desire to similarly contribute to and serve the Parish in one or more of these ministries, because there is always something to do in a Parish and I would be most keen to hear from anyone who can offer a great idea for consideration. The third tranche of ministries that are being recognised include the following:

- Those who have served as RCIA Catechists and Sponsors across the three RCIA Programs that have operated in our Parish in 2024.
- Members of the Parish Pastoral Council, chaired by Eva Cusack.
- Those who serve as volunteers to the Parish Computer Project, a project that was pioneered by the late John Carr.
- All who serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Communion (i.e. Communion Ministers).
- All those who serve in the privileged position of being Altar Servers.

And speaking of Altar Servers, I would like to expressly mention the service of Katharine Greathead. In my time as Parish Priest, I have admired the competence, dedication, and attention to detail of Katharine in her ministry as an Altar Server. Katharine has been a faithful Altar Server for 8.5 years, and now, having soon to begin her eighteenth year of life, she has decided to retire from that ministry. On behalf of the Parish, I sincerely thank her for her years of dedicated service, particularly to the Holy Trinity Church community. I know that our Parish family will miss having her as an Altar Server. Thank you Katharine.

The Parish's second and final Second Rite of Reconciliation service will be held tomorrow (Monday) night in the Corpus Christi Church, Nundah. The service will start promptly at 6:30pm. The Second Rite differs from the First Rite in that it is a community celebration that incorporates individual confession. All are most welcome. Besides this Penitential Rite, the final formal opportunity for confession (the First Rite version) before Christmas, will be this Saturday in the Banyo church between 3:45pm and 4:45pm. Of course, I am also open to hear confessions by prior appointment if I have space in my diary, but with Christmas bearing down on us, and the busyness that comes at this time, I doubt that there will be many vacancies in the diary.

Please take the opportunity to note in your own calendars our four Parish Christmas Mass times, and to plan ahead with which particular Masses or Masses suit you and your family. The final Christmas Day Mass will be the 9:30am one at Nundah. Also, if you are an Extraordinary Minister of the Word or Eucharist, or an Altar Server, or musician or singer, and you are available to assist with the celebration any of our Christmas Masses, please ensure that you do report to the Parish Office your availability because these Masses are generally hard to fill with volunteer ministers. 
We have many wonderful people who give their time, talent and treasure. We would like to take the opportunity to acknowledge all those who do that in our Parish community.
