
Fourth Sunday of Advent 22 December 2024 — Year C

Blessing of the Advent Wreath Candle - Week 4 - Faith

Fr Dan: Father, we ask you to bless ★ this fourth candle, as we celebrate *Faith*.

Faithful God, you sent into the world your beloved Son, whom we call Emmanuel.

As we light this fourth candle, increase our *Faith* and help us to prepare to welcome the Christ Child.



All: May the flame of Christ's coming grow brighter and brighter. May the Lord of Light come into each of our hearts and into our world.

Dear Parishioners.

As my parents would say to me and my siblings when I was a young child, 'Only four more sleeps until Christmas,' as my family counted down the days to the great event of the birth of the Christ-child. Perhaps some of you may have had a similar experience. But my point is that Christmas is literally days away, with our first Parish Christmas Masses, our Vigil Masses, occurring on Tuesday night.

In the final rundown to Christmas, we recall that today we celebrate the fourth and final Sunday in the Season of Advent. And during this Mass (being the first Mass in either church, we will bless and light our fourth Advent Wreath Candle. In additional, the Parish will also recognise and honour the fourth tranche of those ministries that provide a meaningful service to us in the Parish and also to the broader community. In fact, this group is more of a catch-all for all who serve the Parish and who may have inadvertently not been singled out. So, these are the ministries that we so honour today:

- Those who serve in the Children's Liturgy of the Word.
- Our church musicians.
- Those who serve as Extraordinary Ministers of the Word (our Readers).
- Those who take-up the collections during Mass.
- Those who count and bank the weekly collection monies.
- Those who serve as our Local Safeguarding Representative (LSR) and advise on Workplace Health and Safety (WHS) matters.
- Those who visit our local State Schools to offer a catechesis lessons to the Catholic students therein.
- Those who have assisted with the planning of liturgical celebrations throughout the vear.
- Those who helped organise and coordinate our Parish's inaugural Corpus Christi Church Procession through Nundah Village in 2024.
- And all those who participate in sundry ways around our churches and in the Parish that have not been so honoured previously.

A brief recap on those who have been honoured across the past three weekends, so that we can visually see and appreciate the gamut and variety of ministries that occurs in our Parish.
