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FACT SHEET

What is the Australian Christian Art Prize?

The Australian Christian Art Prize is an annual national art competition that is open to artists in two categories: an Open category and a Senior Student (Years 11 or 12) category. The competition is an initiative of Banyo Nundah Catholic Parish.

What specifications might apply to art entries?

The Art Prize is open to all works of art that address Christian themes. Such themes could include portrayals of scenes from the life of our Lord Jesus Christ, or the Bible, or the lives of Saints, of Christian spirituality, of Christian values and life, or God's creation and His promises to humanity. Eligible mediums include painting, drawing, digital works, sculpture, and installations.

How much does it cost to enter the Art Prize competition?

There is an entry fee that is payable per piece of art. For the Open category, the fee is \$55; the Senior Student fee is \$25.

What are the prizes?

The winner of the Open category will receive \$10,000. The winner of the Senior Student category will receive \$5,000. There is also an Encouragement Prize of \$2,000.

When will the competition judging occur and winners announced?

Final judging of the submissions will occur in the Hanly Room, Francis Rush Centre, Elizabeth Street, Brisbane, on Thursday, 17 July and the winners will be announced on Friday, 18 July, during the official opening reception commencing at 6:00pm.

When will the Art Exhibition begin and end?

The Art Exhibition will officially begin at 6:00pm, 18 July, with the Official Opening and announcement of winner's names. The Exhibition is being held in the Hanly Room, Francis Rush Centre, Elizabeth Street, Brisbane. Entrance fee for the Official Opening is \$25/person. Entrance to the Public Exhibition between Saturday, 19 July and Friday 25 July, is free. The Public Exhibition will be open between 10:00am and 3:00pm.

What might volunteers be required to do?

There are several jobs that the Parish will require the assistance of volunteers. They range from bumping-in and out of the art works (i.e. putting the pieces of art on display and their subsequent removal), serving food and drinks during the Official Opening event, and supervising the Public Exhibition between 18 – 25 July inclusive. The following are the jobs that we are seeking volunteers for:
