Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time—Year C 6th July, 2025

Dear Parishioners,

I celebrate my twenty-third year of priestly ordination this weekend - Saturday, 5 July. My ordination anniversaries tend to sneak up on me because I rarely give much thought to them. But, when I do become conscious of their nearness, I pause and reflect on the huge honour and privilege that God has afforded me to serve both Him and the People of God in the ministerial priesthood. I am humbled that the Lord chose me to be a pastor assisting our Archbishop to watch over the flock entrusted into his care. And when I reflect over the past years, I have no regrets at all in taking up my cross and following Jesus as a priest.

In last weekend's Newsletter Message, I wrote at length about the **Australian Christian Art Prize (ACAP)** competition that our Parish is conducting. As this is the inaugural year of ACAP, it is important that we do get off to a great start, because, how well we organise and run the event, will either enhance or detract its reputation. That is why I again write to seek the participation and help from Parishioners.

You will recall that a Fact Sheet supplement was included in last weekend's Newsletter. This weekend, I hope that there might be a tremendous response from you, the Parishioners, volunteering your help. We need men's help (because there will be some lifting involved) to bump-in and out (hanging-up and removing them) the artworks. Then we need help on the Exhibition's Opening Night event in serving finger food and drinks to the guests. And then, we need help for people to work as receptionists and quasi-security guards (to ensure that the artworks aren't stolen or vandalised), and not necessarily the same people, for the duration of the public showing of the ACAP Exhibition. The bottom of the Fact Sheet could be completed by volunteers and torn-off and returned to the Parish by placing them in this weekend's Mass Collection baskets.

The ACAP competition is strategically important to the Parish because it serves as an external income stream which the Parish will benefit from, and I'll now explain in part why that is so.

Very shortly, the Parish will expend almost \$1M on maintenance and repairs to the Corpus Christi Church, that's perhaps only 25% of the total work needed to be done. Back in my predecessor, Fr Bernie Gallagher's, term as Parish Priest, the Parish costed out the restoration costs of the work identified his predecessor, Fr Paul Chandler, in the Corpus Christi Church's Restoration Plan approved by the National Trust. In the early 2020's, the work was estimated to cost approximately \$1.3M. Well, with the escalation of labour, building materials and equipment, costs have ballooned significantly, and so, my revised estimation of the total cost of the works is perhaps \$4M+.

Having building construction management qualifications, I anticipated this exponential rise in costs immediately upon taking over as Parish Priest, and I moved quickly to promote the Building Restoration Fund in this Parish, and to seek a relaxation from the Archdiocese for a period of three years from paying Archdiocesan taxes on the donated monies received in the fundraising activity. The target was \$1M.

With some 8 months still to run on the tax exemption, we have raised \$280K. A few Parishioners have been regular donors since the inception of the fundraising initiative began around May 2023, and on behalf of the Parish, I acknowledge your support, and I sincerely thank you for your generosity.

Since it is very likely that our fundraising for the Restoration Fund after three years will be well short of the \$1M target, your Parish Finance Council (PFC) have turned its attention to how it might seek a strong external income stream, and that is how the ACAP initiative came into being, and for the ACAP to be a steady future external income, we need your help as volunteers. So, then, if you haven't fully considered helping the Parish with the running of our ACAP competition, I urge you to consider again, how you might be able to help us.
