Notice of Temporary Relocation – Corpus Christi Church

The Parish has entered into a contract with **Realm Building Solutions** to carry out essential repairs at Corpus Christi Church.

This work is tentatively scheduled to commence on Monday, 21 July, and will include:

- Reglazing the stained-glass windows located beneath the dome
- Repainting the high external areas of the building
- Repainting the interior of the dome

While these tasks represent only part of the church's overall maintenance needs, they focus on areas that are typically difficult to access without expensive scaffolding or specialised equipment. For this reason, your Parish Finance Council has prioritised these works — ensuring that all equipment hire is done once, rather than multiple times. This approach helps to reduce overall costs and make the most of available resources.

From **Monday, 21 July**, *Corpus Christi Church will be temporarily closed* for all liturgical celebrations while essential works are carried out. We anticipate reopening in **late September**, with the closure expected to last approximately **eight weeks**.

During this time, **all Parish services** — including **Masses, baptisms, confessions, and funerals** — will take place at **Holy Trinity Church, Banyo**.

To accommodate this temporary arrangement, **some service times will be adjusted**. With all liturgies located in one church, there is no longer a need to travel between sites on weekends. These changes aim to support both my own responsibilities and those of our dedicated Banyo Sacristan, **Val Stafford**.

We'll keep you informed, and the revised schedule will remain in place until we return to Corpus Christi Church.

Thank you for your understanding and continued support.

Support for One Another

I encourage everyone to support one another during this transitional phase, as all services will be temporarily held at Banyo.

I understand that having every celebration at Banyo for the foreseeable future may cause inconvenience, particularly for those who usually walk to Sunday Mass at Nundah. Perhaps a kind-hearted Parishioner might consider coordinating a carpool to help fellow Parishioners attend.

One of our pressing concerns is the limited number of ministerial volunteers currently serving at Banyo. This team is already stretched with two Sunday Masses, and now must manage four. I sincerely hope that our valued Readers, Communion Ministers, musicians, and choir members from Nundah will continue offering their generous service at the corresponding Masses in Banyo.

Your continued support and cooperation are deeply appreciated.



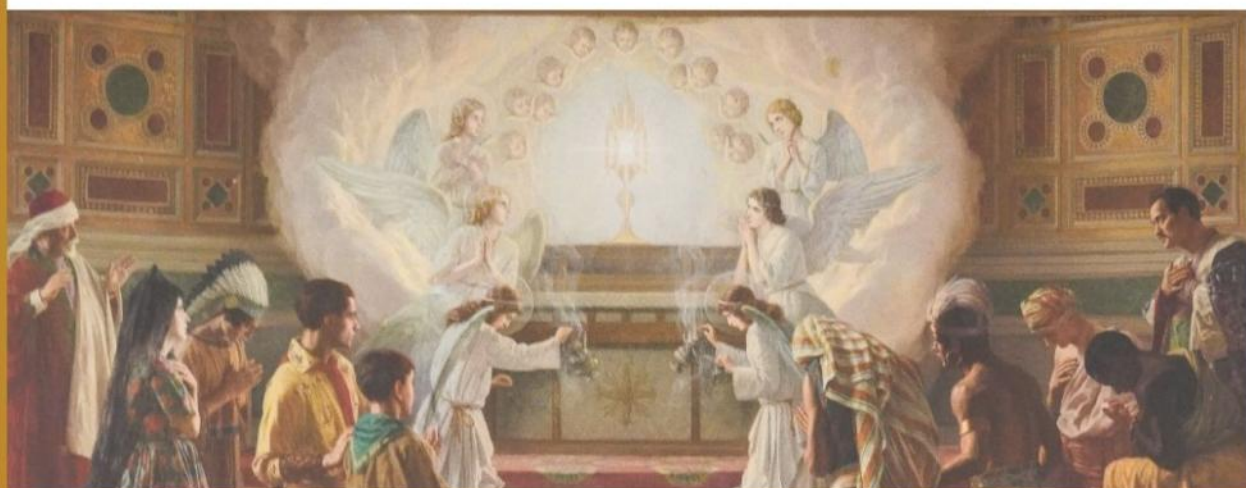
