If you're in the Brisbane CBD this week, I encourage you to visit the exhibition in the Hanly Room, located on the ground floor of the Francis Rush Centre, next to St Stephen's Cathedral. It's a wonderful opportunity to see inspiring Christian art.

We hope it will grow into a respected national art competition and a valuable source of income for our Parish. Congratulations to Bill and the PFC for bringing this vision to life.
