Annual Catholic Campaign

Next weekend, during all Sunday Masses, we will hold the Archdiocese's Annual Catholic Campaign. Initiated by Archbishop Mark in 2013, this Campaign consolidated four separate annual collections into one—responding to concerns that special collections were occurring almost every other weekend. The change was warmly welcomed across the Archdiocese.

Since then, the Campaign has evolved. The original four beneficiaries—The Priests Foundation, Centacare, Holy Spirit Seminary, and the MacKillop Fund—remain, with donations distributed equally among them. These contributions are tax-deductible. A fifth, non-tax-deductible option now supports grassroots parish projects that help grow local ministries.

This weekend, ahead of the Campaign, members of our Parish Finance Council will briefly speak after we pray the Jubilee Prayer.

Campaign brochures with tear-off donation envelopes are available near the church doors. Please take one home per household, complete the donation section, and return it at next Sunday's Mass or post it directly to the Campaign office.



Nundah Church Repairs – Progress Update

- ☒ Roof tile repairs (including cracked/missing tiles and ridge tile re-mortaring) are complete.
- ☒ Stolen downpipes have been replaced.
- ☐ Restoration of the 24 stained glass dome windows is underway offsite.
- ☐ External repainting of high church elements is in progress.
- ☐ A bee infestation in the external brick cavity walls has been resolved.
- ☐ The overall project remains on schedule.

Inside the church, scaffolding is being erected beneath the dome to allow for plaster repairs, followed by repainting of the dome and surrounding arches.
