This weekend across the Archdiocese, we launch the **2025 Annual Catholic Campaign** (ACC). Last Sunday, several Parish Councillors spoke at our Masses to introduce the Campaign and invited you to take home a pledging envelope. Many of you did — thank you!

If you missed last weekend or didn't collect an envelope, we've placed a few around the church for your convenience. You'll find them on the aisle seats.

Our guest speakers reminded us of the many ways to contribute: cash, credit card, cheque, money order, or direct debit. You can also donate digitally by scanning the QR code on the envelope. A larger version of the QR code will be displayed on the church monitors during my brief address at the start of Mass.

I'm pleased to share that our parish ranked among the top fifteen contributors to the 2024 ACC — a wonderful achievement! With your continued generosity, I pray we can match or even exceed that result this year.

Today's homily will be a recorded message from Archbishop Mark Coleridge, our Apostolic Administrator. It may be his final formal address to the Archdiocese, and he will reflect on the ACC Appeal in light of today's Gospel.

Please note: there will be **one collection** at each Sunday Mass this weekend, **combining both the regular parish offering and ACC donations**. If you're contributing to the ACC, kindly place your sealed pledging envelope along with your parish gift into the collection basket as it's passed around before the Offertory.

Next weekend, during the Saturday 6:00pm Vigil and Sunday 9:00am and 5:00pm Masses, our First Holy Communion candidates will receive the Sacrament. Please keep these children in your prayers as they take this important step in their faith journey.


