Corpus Christi Church Repairs Update

It's been 10 weeks since we've gathered in our beloved Corpus Christi Church, and many parishioners — myself included — are longing to return to its sacred beauty and resume our liturgical life there. This longing is evident in the number of families choosing to defer baptisms until they can be celebrated at Corpus Christi.

Last Wednesday, I spoke with the contractor's project manager, Steve Bohlsen. Weather permitting, we expect to resume services on the weekend of 18 October — just three weeks away.

As I write, the internal scaffolding is being dismantled following the dome works. Final repainting will be completed using a mobile cherry picker.

The site was handed over to the contractor on 21 July, with the project scheduled to run for 13 weeks. Upon our return, the church carpark will also be fully accessible — no more scrambling for kerbside spots on Bage Street!
