
Dear Parishioners,

Last weekend marked the completion of our final Sacramental Program for 2025 — First Holy Communion. At two of the three Masses, I invited our newly initiated young Catholics to consider joining our Altar Server ministry. I regret not extending that invitation at all three Masses, so I now warmly invite

all children who have completed their Sacraments to consider serving in this special role. Altar Servers have the unique honour of assisting the priest during liturgical celebrations, answering the Second Vatican Council's call for "full, conscious, and active participation" in the liturgy (Sacrosanctum Concilium, Ch 1, Part II, No 14). Parents, please discuss this opportunity with your children, and if they're interested, contact the Parish Office (details opposite) so we can arrange training.





This Thursday morning, Archbishop-elect Shane Mackinlay will be installed as the eighth Archbishop of Brisbane, succeeding Archbishop Mark Coleridge. Due to limited seating
