There are two important matters that I wish to report on in this Message.

Re-occupancy of Corpus Christi Church, Nundah

Many are asking: *When will Mass resume at Corpus Christi Church?*

I spoke with the Site Manager on Thursday morning. He's hopeful that internal painting, pew repositioning, and a thorough clean will be completed by **Friday, 17 October**. However, this leaves little time to return furnishings before the originally planned **Saturday, 18 October** Mass.

To allow for proper setup, our **first Mass back** will now be **Saturday, 25 October at 6:00pm**. From this date, we'll return to our regular liturgical schedule across both churches.

Thank you to our Nundah regulars for your patience during this time.

Please note: while the church will be accessible from 25 October, the **carpark may not be fully available** due to damage caused during renovations. The builder is responsible for repairs, but they may not be completed in time. If needed, please park on the kerb and walk a little further.

A heartfelt thanks to the **Holy Trinity, Banyo** community for your generosity over the past 15 weeks. Special thanks to **Val Stafford**, our Banyo Sacristan, who doubled her usual duties—covering every Sunday and weekday Mass, Saturday baptisms, and funerals. Catholic Missions Appeal


