Dear Parishioners,

I'd like to share a few important updates with you regarding our Parish:

1. Debra Visser's Recovery

We're grateful to share that our Parish Manager, Debra Visser, was discharged from hospital on Thursday, 16 October, and is now recovering at home. While she initially expected to be away for the remainder of the year, her doctors have advised a shorter recovery period. Deb plans to return to work on Monday, 3 November. This means our Parish Office will resume normal Tuesday operations from after that date. Please continue to keep Deb in your prayers as she regains her strength.

2. Corpus Christi Church Repairs

Repairs to the church building are nearly complete. The interior repairs are complete, the building has been cleaned, and the pews that were removed to make way for the nested scaffolding have been returned. However, the carpark remains under repair and will stay closed for safety reasons until the carpark surface work is finished. The Contractor has placed barricades around the carpark areas that he has to reinstate to a condition equal to what it was like before they took possession of the site. This means that we will not have full access to the entire carpark, but most of it. The partial access to the carpark may cause some Parishioners an inconvenience, and I appreciate your patience, understanding and tolerance until those carpark repairs are completed. I extend the Parish's thanks to the Builder, Realm Building Solutions, and in particular to their Site Manager, Steve Bohlsen, for the work that have completed for us. I pray that the completion of the carpark reconsolidation of its road base in the damaged areas and their asphalt resurfacing will be completed quickly.

3. RCIA Program

We now have 10 candidates preparing to journey into the Catholic faith—our largest group since I became your Parish Priest. With the support of 7 sponsors and 5 catechists, we will begin our RCIA program on Saturday, 1 November (All Saints Day), following the 9:00am Mass at Corpus Christi. Thank you to all who have volunteered and to everyone offering prayers for our candidates and team.

4. Parish Consultative Council (PCC)

At today's 9:30am Mass in Nundah, we will commission our inaugural PCC Councillors. These seven parishioners will serve as your representatives and support me in guiding our Parish. They may call on you to assist with various committees, and I encourage you to respond generously when asked. Together, we can continue to build a vibrant and caring community.

May the Lord bless you and your families abundantly in the week ahead.
