Naturally, Deb's temporary absence will affect our day-to-day parish operations. I've reached out to Carmel, Jill, and Rosemary, who have graciously offered to help carry portions of Deb's workload. I'm deeply grateful for their generosity and willingness to serve. At the same time, I'm mindful that each of them has personal and family commitments, which means the Parish Office will not be open five days a week as usual.

Our aim is to keep the Office open four days each week. While Tuesday (my rest day) would be the most logical day to close, scheduling realities mean that closure will alternate between Tuesday and Wednesday for the time being. This week, the Office will be closed on **Tuesday**.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate this temporary adjustment together.
