World Youth Day

Dear Parishioners,

As we come to the final Sunday of the liturgical year — the 34th Week in Ordinary Time — we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. What a fitting way to conclude the year: by proclaiming Christ as King of all creation, the fullness of God's creative love.

And yet, today's Gospel surprises us. We hear not of triumph in worldly terms, but of Jesus crucified between two thieves. One, whom tradition names St Dismas, turns to Jesus in a final act of faith: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." And Jesus replies with mercy beyond measure: "Today you will be with me in paradise."

This is the kind of King we follow — one who reigns not with power and privilege, but with love, humility, and forgiveness. His throne is the Cross, and his crown is compassion. Thanks be to God that this is the King who welcomes us into his eternal home.

Next Sunday begins a new liturgical year — Cycle A for Sundays, Cycle 2 for weekdays — as we enter the Season of Advent. St John the Baptist calls us to prepare the way of the Lord. Let us take his call to heart, for we "know not the hour or the day." How will we respond?

Liturgical Ministries - A Call to Serve

Friends, we are facing ongoing challenges in rostering ministers, especially Extraordinary Ministers of the Word and Eucharist. Recently, at a Saturday evening Mass, I had no one to assist with Communion, and the Precious Blood could not be offered to the faithful. This grieves me deeply.

There have also been occasions when rostered readers have not arrived, leaving others to step in at the last minute. While we manage as best we can, this is not ideal — and it sends a message to visitors that our parish may lack the vibrancy we know is in our hearts.



With Christmas approaching and many ministers away, we risk being short at our four Christmas Masses. I ask you sincerely: please consider offering your time and gifts in service. I would be glad to provide training for new volunteers. If you feel called to help, contact the Parish Office.
