Fr Dan's Surgery Update & Flocknote Communication

On Wednesday morning — the day before my scheduled surgery — I was informed that my surgeon had fallen ill, and as a result, the procedure has been postponed. It is now rescheduled for the early afternoon of Tuesday, **December 9**.

Those subscribed to our e-Newsletter via **Flocknote** would have received an update from our Parish Manager that same afternoon, including the news that, with the surgery delayed, I would resume celebrating **Weekday and Sunday Masses from Thursday, November 13**. In other words, all parish liturgies and services have resumed as normal.

If you're not yet registered on Flocknote, you may have been surprised to see me back at the altar—especially after last weekend's Newsletter Message and the announcements at Sunday Masses. This highlights the importance of Flocknote, which the Archdiocese has adopted as its principal communication and data platform. Our parish has followed suit.

Situations like this — where plans change unexpectedly — require swift and reliable communication. Those already registered on Flocknote received timely updates. I strongly encourage all parishioners to register, so you can stay informed about important parish news.

Some have expressed concerns about Flocknote's security, particularly regarding personal information. Please be assured: Flocknote is safe. The Parish does not request banking details when you register. The Archdiocese uses a secure data management system, with daily backups, and no financial information (such as BSB or account numbers) is collected.

If you or your family have not yet registered, I warmly urge you to do so using our Parish Flocknote link.

Upcoming Mass Cancellations

Although Masses have resumed for now, **Weekday Masses will be cancelled from Wednesday, December 9 to Friday, December 19** to allow for my surgery and recovery. I'll remind you again in the Newsletter Message the weekend before.

I sincerely apologise for any inconvenience caused by the sudden change in plans. Thank you for your understanding and prayers.

Corpus Christi Church Carpark Repairs

On Thursday, November 13, the contractor returned to the Nundah site and completed the restoration of the damaged carpark paving at Corpus Christi Church. The carpark is now fully operational, and the builder has reached **practical completion** of the works.

Pastoral Visitors offer friendship, hope, and spiritual support to incarcerated women through weekly visits - being a living sign of God's love and mercy.


Training, mentoring, and ongoing support are provided.
