The Month of November

November is a sacred time for remembering and praying for the dead.

Traditionally, the faithful may request Masses to be offered for deceased loved ones. **November Mass Intention envelopes** are now available near the front and side doors of both churches. I apologise for the delay in making them available — Parish matters distracted me more than I'd like to admit.

If you wish to request a Mass, please complete and return an envelope as soon as possible. Envelopes received after mid-November may not be scheduled within the month.

Books of Remembrance

Our **Books of Remembrance** are again placed in both churches. You are invited to write the names of deceased loved ones to be remembered in the prayers of the Parish community throughout November.

- At Banyo: under the St Mary of the Cross picture (behind the baptismal font)
- At Nundah: on the Sacred Heart of Jesus side altar

All Souls' Day

Today, the Church commemorates All the Faithful Departed (All Souls). As it falls on a Sunday this year, it takes precedence over the 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time.

Plenary Indulgence on All Souls' Day

A plenary indulgence — complete remission of temporal punishment due to sin — may be obtained today for a deceased soul. This indulgence can be applied to one soul per year, but its effect is immediate and lasting. It is a profound act of mercy for the deceased and a source of consolation for the intercessor as they can confidently believe that they have done as much as possible for the eternal soul of their loved one.

To obtain the indulgence, the faithful must:

- Visit a church on 2 November
- Pray the Lord's Prayer and the Creed

Additionally, the following conditions must be met:

- Sacramental confession and absolution
- Reception of Holy Communion
- Pray for the Pope's intentions

The Church teaches that a plenary indulgence benefits a soul by releasing it into the joy of Heaven. Regrettably, if a soul has been condemned to Hell, it cannot benefit from the completion of a plenary indulgence — this is affirmed in the *Parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus* (Luke 16:19–31).

Let us pray with hope that our loved ones may rest in the eternal presence of the


