Sadly, our nation was shaken by the terrible terrorist attack last Sunday evening at Bondi Beach, Sydney, targeting innocent Jewish people gathered for Hanukkah. Regardless, the rise in antisemitism in Australia since the October 8, 2023, Hamas attack, and the tolerance of such acts by government authorities, is unacceptable. Every Australian deserves to feel safe in their homes, workplaces, and communities.

As we near the joy and peace of Christmas, our hearts are burdened by this tragedy. I encourage our Catholic community to keep the Jewish community in our prayers, that those mourning their loved ones may find comfort in knowing they are surrounded by friends.

May the words of Pope Leo XIV, responding to the Bondi Beach attack, guide us: "Enough with these forms of antisemitic violence! We must eradicate hatred from our hearts."

May God bless you and your families. I look forward to celebrating Christmas with you all.
