RCIA Journey

Lent will soon be upon us — Ash Wednesday (18 February) is just over two weeks away — and our Parish is already preparing for this sacred season.

For our seven RCIA participants, Lent and especially the Easter Vigil (4 April) are central moments in their journey toward full communion with the Church and with our Parish community. The RCIA team has discerned that the key liturgical steps for our Catechumens and Candidates will take place during the 7:30am Sunday Mass at Holy Trinity Church. Their reception into the Church will be celebrated at the Easter Vigil in Corpus Christi Church, Nundah.

This morning at the 7:30am Mass, our three Catechumens — Leon Hansen, Isabelle Beattie, and Ashlee Kresevic — will receive the pre-baptismal anointing. While infant baptism happens within a single ceremony, the RCIA journey unfolds over many months, with today's anointing being one of its important milestones. Traditionally, oil was used to strengthen and sustain workers; symbolically, this anointing strengthens our Catechumens to resist sin and to persevere in faith.

Please keep Leon, Isabelle, and Ashlee in your prayers, along with our four Candidates — Hayley Freestun, Michelle Freestun, Rebecca Ibarra, and Tevita Toloi — as they continue their journey toward full reception into the Church.

Candlemas

Tomorrow, Monday 2 February, we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord — traditionally known as Candlemas. During this Mass, the candles used in our liturgies for the coming year will be blessed. Parishioners are warmly invited to bring candles from home (for prayer spaces or family devotions) to be blessed as well.
