Lent begins this Wednesday with Ash Wednesday. To support commuters, Mass will be offered at **6:30am (Nundah)** and **9:00am (Banyo)**, with the blessing and distribution of ashes at both.

Ash Wednesday and **Good Friday** are days of fast and abstinence; all other Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting binds those aged 18–59, and abstinence from age 14.

Lent is a privileged time to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance. In addition to the usual **Saturday Confessions (3:45–4:45pm, Banyo)**, a **Second Rite** will be celebrated at Nundah **on Wednesday, 11 March at 7:00pm**. Limited appointments for individual confession are also available at the Parish Centre on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.

As part of our Nundah centenary year, the Parish has purchased copies of the 2026 Lenten reflection booklet **The Journey Home** (25 per church). These are available free of charge until supplies run out.

Our **RCIA program** continues to progress beautifully. Last Sunday our three Catechumens were enrolled as the **Elect**. Today at the **7:30am Banyo Mass**, they will celebrate their **First Scrutiny**. After Mass, Madonna Hoelscher and the Care and Concern team will host breakfast for all. This is a wonderful opportunity to meet the Elect, their Sponsors, and the catechetical team. Similar gatherings will accompany future Scrutiny celebrations. My sincere thanks to Madonna and her helpers.

This Sunday's **5:00pm Mass** will be our first **Family Mass** of 2026. I am grateful to the St Pius V School community for hosting and for providing a light supper afterwards. All are warmly invited to stay.

May the Lord bless you abundantly in these early days of Lent.
