The ashes placed on our foreheads remind us of life's fragility, the need for conversion, and the truth that our lasting reward is found in God alone. Though the ashes wash away, their meaning remains written on our hearts. Today's Responsorial Psalm gives voice to the contrition we seek throughout Lent: *"Have mercy on me, God, in your kindness... O wash me more and more from my guilt and cleanse me from my sin"* (Ps 51:1-2). May this be the measure of our Lenten journey.
