Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time — Year A 8th February 2026

Dear Parishioners

This week, I wish to speak frankly about our Parish ministries.

At present, we are facing significant challenges in recruiting and retaining ministers. This affects the quality of our liturgical celebrations — something none of us desires. I know our Parish is capable of more, yet many remain hesitant to offer their time and gifts. The situation is especially critical at the **6:00pm Saturday (Nundah)** and **5:00pm Sunday (Banyo)** Masses, with only slightly better coverage at the **7:30am Banyo** and **9:30am Nundah** Masses.

We urgently need parishioners to serve as **Readers, Communion Ministers, Altar Servers, Sacristans, Collectors, Offertory Processors, and Welcomers**. Increasingly, I have had to ask ministers to take on multiple roles at a single Mass — something far from ideal. One person, one ministry remains the standard we strive for.

Over the past three years, I have repeatedly raised this concern, and while a small number of parishioners have generously stepped forward (for whom I am sincerely grateful), the response has not been enough to ease the strain — particularly at the evening Masses.

As we enter two significant jubilee years — **the Nundah church centenary in 2026** and **the Banyo church golden anniversary in 2027** — this is a fitting moment for our community to renew its commitment to service. Let us present our Parish at its best by ensuring our liturgies are well supported.

Soon, the Banyo Sunday Masses will transition to **Easy Worship 7**, replacing PowerPoint. This creates another ministry opportunity for those comfortable with basic computer use. The software is simple to learn and suitable for pre-teens through adults.

I also wish to renew the call for **Altar Servers**. Several children expressed interest after their First Holy Communion last year, but I cannot recall all their names. I invite those children — or their parents — to contact me so training can begin.

The Lord has blessed our Parish with many talents. I ask parishioners of all ages to prayerfully consider offering those gifts in service to our community. Ministry is not only a help to the Parish; it is spiritually enriching and fulfils the Second Vatican Council's vision of full and active participation in the liturgy.

I hope many of you will respond generously to this call.
