Dear Parishioners

In recent weeks our Parish has experienced a number of changes and last minute adjustments. Some events, such as the **Second Rite of Reconciliation** and the postponement of the **Home, Heart & Soul Seminar**, have unfolded with very little notice. While this sometimes happens in parish life, I am conscious that it can make planning difficult for many of you.

One such event now approaching quickly is our Parish Retreat **this coming Saturday, 21 March**. Although mentioned briefly in earlier newsletters, it has not yet received the attention it deserves, so I would like to warmly invite you to join us.

This Retreat is the first of three major celebrations marking the **centenary of our Corpus Christi Church, Nundah**. The other two will be our **Corpus Christi Street Procession on Sunday, 7 June**, and our **Formal Parish Dinner on Friday, 9 October**.

Although the Retreat celebrates the Nundah centenary, it will be held at **Holy Trinity Church, Banyo**, where the church and Brady Hall provide the space and facilities needed. The day runs from 10:00am to 2:00pm, is **free of charge**, and includes **morning tea, lunch, two input sessions**, and time for quiet reflection. The **Blessed Sacrament** will be exposed in the Side Chapel throughout the Retreat for those who wish to spend time in adoration.

- **11:00am** — Quiet reflection
- **12:00pm** — Lunch and fellowship
- **1:00pm** — Input Session Two: Service of Neighbour
- **2:00pm** — Conclusion

I look forward to sharing this time of prayer and renewal with many of you.

I have also been asked whether our Parish might mark **Divine Mercy Sunday** (12 April) with a special celebration of the **Hour of Mercy**. After prayerful consideration, I am pleased to confirm that we will do so at **Holy Trinity Church**.

The celebration will include:

- **2:00–3:00pm** — Eucharistic Adoration
- **3:00pm** — Recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet
- **3:10pm (approx.)** — Mass
- **2:00–2:50pm** — Confessions available

To allow this special liturgy to take place, the **5:00pm Banyo Mass will be cancelled** on that day. Please note the change in your calendars.

May the Lord shower you with his abundant graces throughout the week ahead.
