Fifth Sunday of Lent — Year A 22nd March 2026

Dear Parishioners

Because I am writing this message ahead of time, I do not yet know how many attended Saturday's Parish Retreat or how they experienced it. My hope is that it was a grace-filled and encouraging day. I am grateful to all who took part, and to our Care and Concern team for their generous catering and support.

Our Parish RCIA program resumes this weekend (21/22 March) after a short break, with a group session on Saturday morning and the Third and Final Scrutiny during the 7:30am Mass at Banyo on Sunday. Only one more Saturday session remains, along with a few final steps, before our seven candidates — **Ashlee Kresevic, Isabelle Beattie, Leon Hansen, Hayley Freestun, Michele Freestun, Rebecca Ibarra and Tivita Tolo** — are received into the Church at the Easter Vigil. Please keep these wonderful people and their families in your prayers as they prepare for this joyful moment.

The Annual Archdiocesan **Chrism Mass** will be celebrated **at the Cathedral of St Stephen on Thursday, 26 March, at 7:00pm**. During this Mass, Archbishop Shane Mackinlay will bless the Holy Oils for use across the Archdiocese in the coming year, and the priests will renew their vows. Space is limited, but the Cathedral Parish has indicated that small groups from each parish are welcome. Rather than organising a group, I invite anyone who wishes to attend to make their own arrangements.

Next weekend is Palm Sunday, the beginning of Holy Week. A small **working bee** will take place at **Banyo House** (the former presbytery) on **Saturday, 28 March, from 7:30am** to cut branches for our Palm Sunday liturgies. Volunteers to help cut these branches are still being sought. Many hands make light work, and it should take no more than half an hour.

The Easter Triduum — the most sacred days of our liturgical year — begins on **Holy Thursday** with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper (**Banyo, 7:00pm, 2 April**). It continues on **Good Friday** with the Celebration of the Lord's Passion (**Nundah, 3:00pm, 3 April**) and concludes on **Holy Saturday** with the Easter Vigil (**Nundah, 7:00pm, 4 April**), during which our RCIA candidates will be received into the Church. I warmly encourage you to enter into these holy days by participating in all three liturgies.

May the Lord shower you with his abundant grace in the week ahead.
