Dear Parishioners

A few important updates have arisen since last week's Newsletter Message was published. I want to *Flocknote* share them with you so that you are fully informed.

1. Home, Heart and Soul Seminar

Unfortunately, the Seminar planned for this Thursday must be postponed. The organisers require at least 50 participants, and we received 15 *Flocknote* registrations. We hope to reschedule later in 2026. My apologies to those who had planned to attend; the Parish will contact you once a new date is confirmed.

2. Australian Christian Art Prize (ACAP)

Our 2026 ACAP Competition must also be deferred. A legal matter concerning our Charitable Deed of Trust is close to resolution, but not in time to run the competition this year. Our inaugural 2025 event established strong goodwill in the art community, and the *Flocknote* Parish Consultative Council (PCC) remains confident that ACAP will grow into a valued evangelising initiative and future income stream when it returns in 2027.

3. 2026 Budget Review

The Parish has been advised that the Banyo OSHC service will not issue a quarterly disbursement for the period ending 31 December 2025. This creates a significant shortfall of approximately \$90,000 in our 2026 Budget. As Bill O'Chee recently noted, *Flocknote* OSHC is both our largest income source and our greatest vulnerability. The PCC and I are now reviewing the Budget to identify responsible adjustments. I hope this will not affect our Corpus Christi centennial celebrations.

4. Upcoming Parish Events

Two important events are approaching quickly:

- **Second Rite of Reconciliation:** Wednesday 11 March, 7:00pm, Corpus Christi Church.
- **Parish Retreat:** Saturday 21 March, 10:00am–2:00pm, Holy Trinity Church. Morning tea and lunch provided. Please notify the Parish Office if you plan to attend *Flocknote* so we can cater appropriately.
