Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord — Year A 29th March 2026

Dear Parishioners,

Today, Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord, we enter the holiest week of the Church's year. At the first Mass celebrated in each church this weekend, we will begin outside with the Blessing of Palms and the Procession of the Lord's Entrance into Jerusalem. The remaining Sunday Masses will include a simple blessing of palms within the liturgy.

Today's two Gospel proclamations — one at the Blessing of Palms and one during Mass — frame our journey with Jesus from his triumphant entry into Jerusalem to his Last Supper, arrest, passion, and death. These readings stand as bookends to this solemn week, leading us toward the joy of his Resurrection on Easter Sunday.

I pray that we may walk together as one Parish family through the Easter Triduum. The times for all Triduum and Easter Sunday liturgies are listed elsewhere in this Newsletter; please take note of them and add them to your calendars.

At this year's Easter Vigil, we will joyfully welcome seven new members into our Parish community: **Leon Hansen, Isabelle Beattie, Ashlee Kresevic, Hayley Freestun, Michelle Freestun, Rebecca Ibarra, and Tevita Tolo.** Thank you for your prayers for these Candidates and their Sponsors throughout their RCIA journey since November 2025.

Those who attend the 7:30am Banyo Mass will already know these Candidates from their various liturgical steps. For others, the Easter Triduum — especially the Easter Vigil — will be a wonderful opportunity to meet and support them.

A reminder that Divine Mercy Sunday (in a fortnight) will be celebrated differently this year. The 5:00pm Banyo Mass will be cancelled. Instead, we will gather for **Exposition and Adoration from 2:00pm, the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 3:00pm**, followed immediately by **Holy Eucharist**. I will be available for Confession between 2:00pm and 3:00pm.

For those praying the **Divine Mercy Novena**, beginning on Good Friday and concluding on Divine Mercy Sunday, printed copies of the prayers are available near the front doors of both churches.

Finally, I was delighted by the strong attendance at last Saturday's Parish Retreat, with 27 participants. The theme — *Service of God and Neighbour* — seems to have resonated deeply, and I am grateful for the positive feedback received. My sincere thanks to **Madonna Hoelscher** and the **Care and Concern team** for their generous and delicious catering.

May God bless you, and may this Holy Week draw each of us closer to the heart of Christ.
