Please mark the date, 7 June, in your calendars. It is a joyful and public witness to our faith in Jesus Christ, and it would be wonderful to see our whole Parish family walking together in unity and thanksgiving.

As we rejoice in the Resurrection, may the peace and hope of the Risen Lord fill your hearts and homes.
